Highlights on ongoing interventions

RCCE

- Community sensitization to key community groups (150 community representatives with reflection of districts) in three (3) regions under the support of WHO.
- Conduct supportive supervision and mentorship at community level to sensitize uptake of COVID-19 vaccines and wave 4 response readiness.
- Reviewed messages to accommodate important aspects of new vaccines

Case Management, IPC, and WASH

- Preparations for the ICU manual, which draft zero is in its final stages this week will be completed and submitted for further action.
- Evaluating Primary Health Care (PHC) and Star rating (SRA) facilities where IPC standards in the KKM area will also be considered in the Five (5) Regions.
- Review and update the various IPC Guidelines so that they can be duplicated and distributed in Health Care Delivery Centers in the Country.

Vaccination

- Developed and launched phase two multi sectoral accelerated community based COVID-19 vaccination strategy on 3rd November 2021.
- Oriented all RMO, RIVO, DMO & DIVOs on Pfizer, Modena, Sinopharm & Sinovac.
- Conducted IAR and disseminated during all RMO, RIVO, DMO & DIVOs meeting in Dodoma on 5th November.

Logistics

- Facilitating the clearing process of Ventilators with their accessories donated by GIZ
- Provision of waiver for importation permit for commodities used for management of COVID-19 Cases
- Updating facilities responsible for reporting commodities used for management of COVID-19 cases

Surveillance

- Participate in review of COVID-19 Response Plan III held in Dar es Salaam
- Conduct meeting for adaptation of Africa CDC EBS training materials and ToT. Training materials were prepared and are being finalized
- Conduct a Virtual EBS meeting and discuss on the challenges associated with alert reporting from the community to national Level
- Conduct pillar meeting on Tuesday 02 November 2021. The minutes with action plan was prepared and shared to all participated stakeholders

Laboratory

- Certification of designed covid-19 testing laboratories in the EAC Partner States NPHL, BMC, DRRH and Mt.Meru.
- Installation of Mobile laboratory at Ngorongoro to operate at Conservation Area under NCAA
- Decentralization process is onboard training are ongoing for RT-PCR to three regions.
- Planning to conduct supervision so that testing for C-19 can begin in 3 regions. Gene sequencing and testing continue.
- communicate with TVLA for joint work in zoonotic disease sample collection

PoE

- Conduct a PoE pillar virtual meeting with PoE stakeholders aimed at discussing implementation of interventions targeted to combat COVID 19 relative to National COVID 19 Response Plan 3.
- Conduct a session to improve and roll out digital Traveller's Health Surveillance System to accommodate existing challenges as well as making it be more efficiency by adding new features
- Screening of travels continued at Points of Entry to prevent the entry of COVID 19 into the country




A. Situational Highlights of COVID-19 from 06 to 12 November 2021 in Tanzania Mainland
