- ✚ Three (3) new COVID-19 confirmed cases and no death were reported this week making a cumulative number of **698** COVID- 19 cases and 37 deaths, additionally three (3) probable cases were reported making a cumulative of **347** probable cases since 31st March 2021.
- ✚ Number of confirmed cases has decreased this week as compared to the last week by 1 case (0.05%).

B. Summary of Pillar updates

- ✚ Coordination meeting for COVID-19 response was held on 23rd February, 2022 with participation of all pillars to provide updates on activities being implemented to combat COVID-19 pandemic and raise challenges and issues need to be discussed during the National task force meeting (NTF) for decision making.
- ✚ Conducted COVID-19 Health facility micro Plan at Pemba in all districts where by 2 participants from health facilities and 3 participants from DHMTs.
- ✚ Conducting supervision to all 20 Health Facilities that providing COVID-19 vaccines in Pemba.
- ✚ Distribution of COVID-19 working tools in all Health facilities that providing COVID-19 vaccines in Unguja and Pemba.
- ✚ Planning meeting for surveillance pillar about EBS training with AMREF and WHO members.
- ✚ On site mentorship on safety and appropriate oxygen use for doctors, nurses sand anesthetist which held on 24th Feb 2022 to 5th March 2022 in all designated health facilities.
- ✚ Pfizer vaccine training for 26 Health facilities and 77 staffs also oriented on working tools materials like registers, ledger and vaccination form.
- ✚ Vaccination pillar participating on the launching of the Mama Mwinyi (President's wife) NGOs which take place at Mau Ze dang stadium on 19 Feb 2022 and the total of 129 people were vaccinated.

C. Conclusion & recommendations

The COVID-19 pandemics continued to be a threat for the general public as well as specific vulnerable groups on the islets, hence MoH continue to urge community members on implementing available public health measures such as **Wearing of Mask, avoid unnecessary gathering, WASH interventions and use of C19 vaccine.**
