- ✚ One (1) new COVID-19 confirmed cases and no death were reported this week making a cumulative number of **707** COVID- 19 cases and 37 deaths, additionally eighteen (18) probable cases were reported making a cumulative of **377** probable cases since 31st March 2021.
- ✚ Number of confirmed cases has decreased this week as compared to the last week by 1 case (0.001%).

- ✚ Collecting of 8 sample of ILI/SARI from Kwamtipura Health Center and sent to National Public Health Laboratory (NPHL) Dar Es Salam.
- ✚ Community sensitization using Mobile Van on the of COVID-19 vaccine uptake. The sensitization take place on 6 districts in Unguja where by different messages used to emphasize the community on COVID-19 vaccines and more than 1000 peoples were reached.
- ✚ Trained 9 health care workers of CHV supervisor and district surveillance officer on events base surveillance (EBS) at Pemba.
- ✚ Conducting a clinical attachment on critical care at Mnazi Mmoja Hospital (MNH) from 14th March 2022 to 27th March 2022.
- ✚ Reviewing of COVID-19 Micro planning in 6 districts which are Magaribi A, Magharibi B, Kati. Kusini, Kaskazini A in Unguja and Micheweni from Pemba.

C. Conclusion & recommendations

The COVID-19 pandemics continued to be a threat for the general public as well as specific vulnerable groups on the islets, hence MoH continue to urge community members on implementing available public health measures such as **Wearing of Mask, avoid unnecessary gathering, WASH interventions and use of C19 vaccine.**
