A. COVID – 19 Situation – Summary highlights

Highlights

- Two (2) new COVID-19 confirmed cases and no death were reported this week making a cumulative number of **754** COVID- 19 cases and 37 deaths, additionally eight (8) probable cases were reported making a cumulative of **486** probable cases since 31st March 2021.
- The reporting rates are 11 districts out of 11 districts (100%).
- Number of confirmed cases decreased by 2 compared to the last week (0.001%).

The COVID-19 pandemics continued to be a threat to the general public as well as specific vulnerable groups on the islets, hence MoH continues to urge community members on implementing available public health measures such as **Wearing Mask, avoiding unnecessary gathering, WASH interventions, and use of C19 vaccine.**
