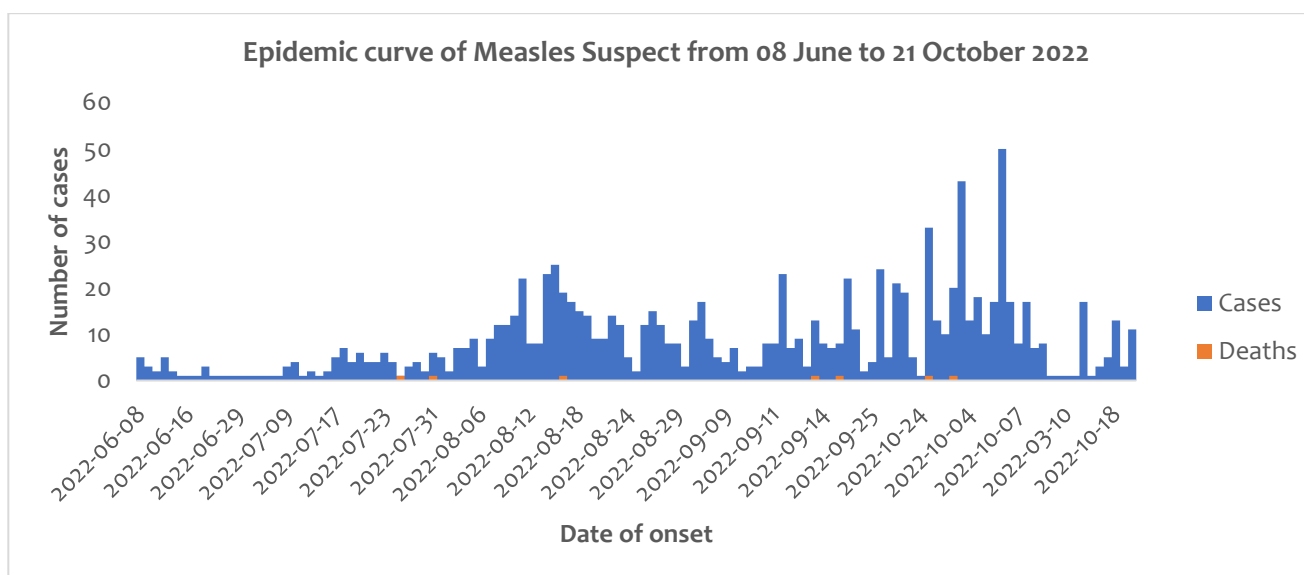

A. Situation – Summary highlights

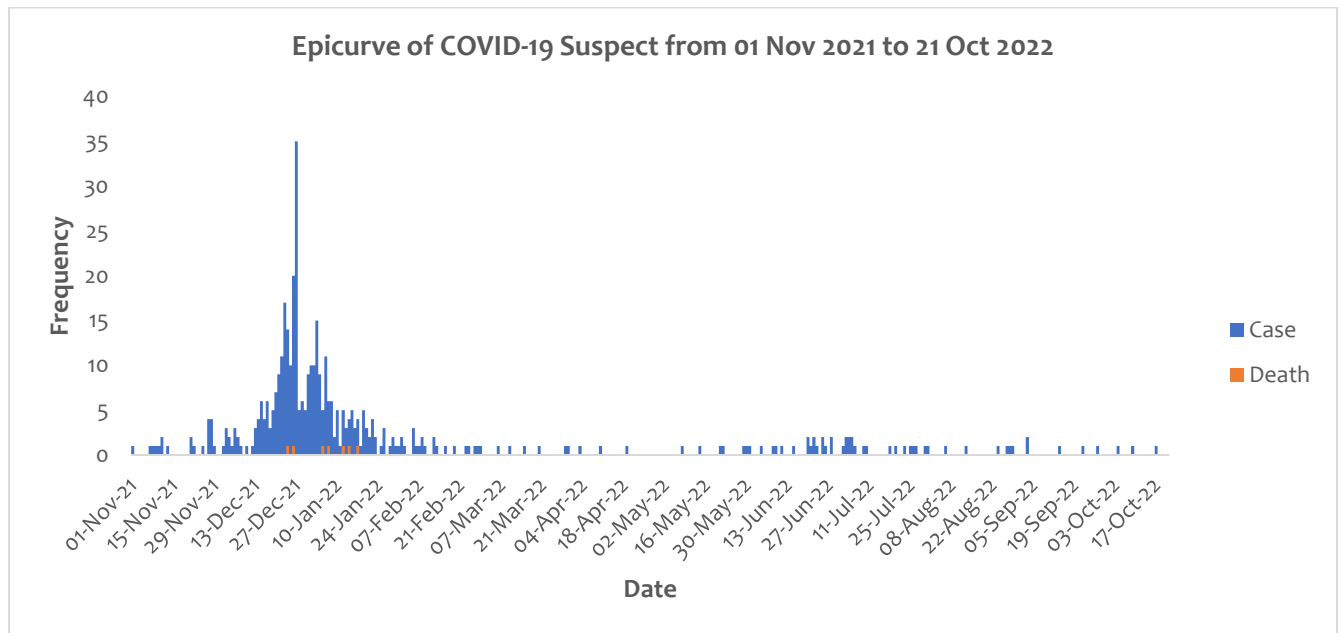

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✚ Two (2) new COVID-19 confirmed case was reported with no death this week making a cumulative number of 759 COVID- 19 cases and 37 deaths. ✚ Zero (0) probable cases were reported making a cumulative of 511 probable cases since 31st March 2021. ✚ The reporting rate is 89% (9 districts out of 11 districts reported) ✚ Number of new confirmed cases increased by 1 compared to the last week. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✚ Two hundred and sixty (260) new suspects were reported. ✚ One (1) new death was reported. ✚ Cumulatively 1,053 suspects and 7 deaths. ✚ The majority of the cases were children aged below 14 years 947 (90%). ✚ The Under five years represent 532 (51%) of all suspects ✚ Sex distribution of cases; 488 (46%) were male and 565 (54%) were females. ✚ A total of 102 admissions have been reported and all admitted patients were not vaccinated. ✚ The majority of cases were reported from Magharibi B (328), Magharibi A (297), and Mjini (106) districts.

c. Response measures

a. Measles

- Conducted community meetings at Kwamtumwajeni, Mapinduzi, Nungwi, Bandamaji, and Kivunge on Measles prevention, and around 200 people were reached.
- Conducted school health sessions on Measles at Fuoni chungu and Istiqama Schools and a total of 50 students were trained.

b. COVID-19

- Community mobilization on COVID-19 by the airing of 2 sessions on the radio (Adhana FM and Salaam FM) and 2 sessions on Tv stations (ZBC TV and Zenibar TV) on messages on the importance of the COVID-19 vaccine uptake.
- Community engagement of Measles and COVID -19 awareness conducted in Urban areas provided education and reached (CHVs 410) Magharibi 'A'&'B' (580) CHVs of Kaskazini 'A'&'B', (310 CHVs), Kati reaches (124 CHVs) and Kusini reaches (69 CHVs,) training conducted for last week ago.
